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Essentially, Kimon Nicolaides felt that the desire to draw was as fundamental and natural as the desire to talk, and drawing, like talking, was about learning how to do things the right way from the beginning. He felt that drawing well had nothing to do with technique, aesthetics or anything else. It depended only on one thing: right observation of the world. He insisted that students had to discover this manner of right observation by themselves, and that the art teacher's job was to ..

His emphasis is on the natural gestures of living things (not just the human figure)--the way the figure carries its weight and form in motion and in opposition to the relentless pull of gravity.
